



Maths Week 2022 – Levels and resources

Maths Week resources are written at five levels as follows (although not all sections have material at all levels – see details below).

- **Level 1** – primarily for Years 1 and 2.
- **Level 2** – primarily for Years 3 and 4.
- **Level 3** – primarily for Years 5 and 6.
- **Level 4** – primarily for Years 7 and 8.
- **Level 5** – primarily for Years 9, 10 and 11.

Maths Week resources are either quizzes or worksheets.

- Quizzes have short answer questions or multiple choice questions.
- Worksheets provide mathematical activities and questions. They can be downloaded and printed by teachers.

The 2022 Maths Week resources are as follows.

- **The Maths Chaser/Whai Pāngarau.** Quizzes at each of levels 2 – 5, with a quiz for each day during Maths Week. An in-class activity. The quizzes can be downloaded and printed by teachers. PowerPoint versions of these quizzes are also available.
- **Maths Millionaire/Kaipāngarau Whai Rawa.** Quizzes, with Years 3 – 5, Years 6 – 8, Years 9 – 11 and family divisions, and with a quiz for each day during Maths Week. The questions for each day are based on a theme. Each quiz is completed on-line. Those who answer all questions correctly can print a certificate. The quizzes for Years 3 – 5 and Years 6 – 8 have also been translated into te reo Māori.
- **Money Money Money/Moni Moni Moni.** Five quizzes to support financial capability (primarily for Years 9 – 11). The questions for each quiz have a theme. Each quiz is completed on-line.
- **Daily Dollar/Ko te Tāra o te Rā.** Worksheets at each of levels 1 – 5.
- **Survivor Series/Kia Mōrehurehu.** Worksheets for in-class tasks at each of levels 1 – 5 for each day during Maths Week. Each day's tasks have a theme (the same theme for all levels).
- **The Basket of Mathematics/Te kete o te Pāngarau.** Five worksheets on various mathematical topics. Primarily written for Years 9 – 11 but could be suitable for some in Years 7 and 8.
- **Super Challenge/Kua takoto te Manuka.** One mathematical challenge question each day for four days during Maths Week. Answers are submitted on-line on the last day of Maths Week. Those who submit correct answers for the questions and the total can print a certificate. Answers are available for teachers in the week following Maths Week.
- **Games.** Two interactive games that students can access on their electronic devices.
