For pupils.




1. You can work with a friend.

3. The school bus comes there are 5 children already on the bus. When Kai and his brother Tama get on the bus how many will there be on the bus now?




4. Kai is 6 years old and has a big brother Tama. Tama is 2 years older than Kai. How old is Kai's big brother?
