
1. You can work with a friend.

5. If you are wrong, answer the question again.
6. There are 5 questions and 2 bonus questions each day.
7. When you have finished each day you will get the magic word to help you find the treasure.
8. At the end of the week put the 5 magic golden words together and find where the treasure is.

2. **On the way to Christchurch they see road signs with the number '100' on them.**
Do these two '50' signs below also add up to 100?



3. She also sees a Stop sign.
It is an Octagon shape.
How many sides does an Octagon have?



4.  When Abby visits her cousins she meets her new twin cousins called Mia and Ella.
She already has 5 cousins.
How many cousins does she have now that the twins are born?

5. Abby and her cousins go to the movies.
It costs \$11 dollars a ticket.
Does Abby have enough to pay for herself?



BONUS QUESTIONS:

6. Abby plays soccer with her cousins on Saturday.
Her team wins by getting 4 goals.
It is 2 more goals than the other team got.
How many goals did the other team get?



7. Abby is 6 years old.
Her oldest cousin Sam is 4 years older than Abbie.
How old is Sam?
