## Thursday: Sports Day!



Bob wakes up excited!  
It is the annual school sports day!  
That means no maths  
(at least that's what Bob thinks!).

1. How often are annual events?



To warm up for the day, Mr Catchit, the PE teacher, tells the children to run three laps around the school field. It takes Tadiwa, the fastest runner in Bob's class, 18 minutes, and Zac, the slowest runner in Bob's class, 24 minutes.

2. How long does it take Tadiwa to run one lap of the field?
3. How long does it take Zac to run one lap of the field?
4. How much longer did it take the Zac to run around the field three times?

Before Bob's class compete in the dodge ball tournament Mr Catchit divides the class into two teams.

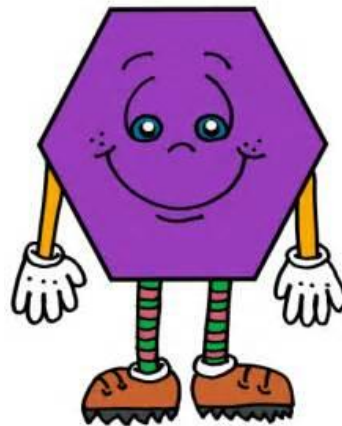
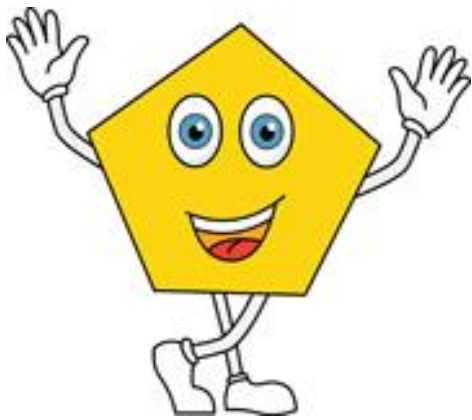
5. If there are 24 children in Bob's class, how many children would be in each team?
6. If there are 30 children in Bob's class, how many children would be in each team?



There are 18 dodge balls at the start of the game.

7. During the game 6 balls get thrown into the trees. How many balls are left to use?
8. Bonnie and Clyde look for the balls and can only find three. How many balls are there at the end of the game?

While Bob is waiting on the field for his next sports event he draws shapes in the dirt.



9. What shape has five sides?
10. What shape has six sides?
11. What shape has one side?
